Patient Inclusion	Women with post-partum haemorrhage who consent
Patient Exclusion:	Contraindications: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Concurrent use of anticoagulants</li> <li>• Thrombosis during pregnancy</li> <li>• Suspected subarachnoid haemorrhage</li> <li>• Significant renal impairment (eGFR less than 30ml /min / 1.73m<sup>2</sup>)</li> <li>• Hypersensitivity</li> <li>• Consent not obtained</li> <li>• Infection at IV site</li> <li>• Use in PPH more than 3 hours after the birth.</li> </ul>
Special Instructions:	Ensure Obstetric doctor and theatre staff have been called to attend (may be in transit while administering)
