WA Country Health Service offers a 12-month full-time pre-physician training program for those interested in pursuing a career as a rural physician.

RAPTOR One is a Basic Physician Training (BPT) preparation program offering excellent rural adult medicine experiences and professional development opportunities to help candidates prepare for the competitive BPT application process in rural WA.

Successful applicants are allocated relevant term rotations, including at least two medical terms, an ED term and a Clinical Service Improvement term.

- CV and interview skills workshops
- Senior physician mentoring
- Research, audit and/or clinical service improvement experience
