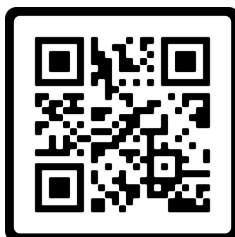

Technology & Healthcare: Synergy at its best!

The WA Country Health Service (WACHS) has a strong history of successfully developing innovative technology solutions and investing in world-class telehealth services to enhance access to high quality health care for country communities.

The WACHS Command Centre brings together new and existing services in a 24/7 'virtual' clinical hub. Using videoconferencing and high-tech information technologies, provides a one-stop shop for country doctors and nurses to access a range of clinical expertise via virtual technologies, supporting acute emergency and inpatient care, including access to mental health specialists, facilitating and coordinating safe, timely and efficient patient transport to and from country and metropolitan hospitals for country patients.

Introduced in 2012, the award winning WACHS Emergency Telehealth Service (ETS) has assisted country clinicians to transform emergency care for country patients presenting to WACHS emergency departments, nursing posts and Silver Chain facilities.

ETS services expanded in 2018, supporting the care of admitted inpatients in the absence of a local doctor in country hospitals via the Inpatient Telehealth Service. This has further contributed to improved patient outcomes, consistency of service and standards, increased governance, and facilitated clinical skill building in the country workforce.

The Mental Health Emergency Telehealth Service (MH ETS) in July 2019 further expanded the number of highly specialised services available to local clinicians via telehealth.

These transformational flow-on effects have enabled WACHS to envision the future of country health care – the WACHS Command Centre.

Command Centre comprises of 6 service streams:

- Acute Patient Transfer Coordination
- Acute Specialist Telehealth Service
- Advanced Patient Monitoring System
- Emergency Medicine Telehealth Service (ETS)
- Inpatient Telehealth Service (ITS)
