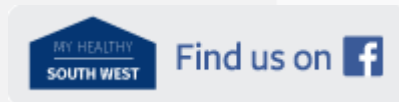

<b>Aged Care Services</b>	<b>Aged Care Assessment Team (ACAT):</b> Assists older people and their carers to understand what care will best meet their needs when they are no longer able to manage at home without assistance.  <b>Patients Awaiting Aged Care Services:</b> This regional service facilitates the seamless transition from hospital to residential or community aged care services.  <b>Regional Older Adult Care Coordination Team:</b> Provide linkage with public at private multi-disciplinary services for older adults at risk including investigating allegations of elder abuse.  <b>Referral process:</b> ACAT referrals by health professional or self-referral via My Aged Care. <b>Child Development Services</b>	Child Development Services are available for families who have children aged from 0 to 18 years of age to support the development of skills such as eating, hearing, talking understanding, movement, hand skills, and social/play skills. This team consists of Audiologists, Dietitians, Occupational Therapists, Paediatrician, Physiotherapists, Podiatrists, Social Workers, Speech Pathologists, Allied Health Assistants.  <b>Referral process:</b> Appointments can be made by phoning Collie Hospital or with the referral form attached on <a href="#">WACHS Child Development Service</a> website.
