June 2017 Board Meeting

The Board Meeting was held on Friday 23 June 2017, at the WA Country Health Service central office 189 Wellington St Perth.

The Board received reports from the Audit and Risk Committee which met on the 12 June 2017 and the Finance Committee which met on the 19 June 2017.

Key Matters for Decision

- The Board endorsed the signing of the WA Country Health Service 2017/18 Service Agreement with the Department of Health.
- The WACHS 2013/14 and 2014/15 Write Off schedules where endorsed.
- Piloting a 'Promoting Professional Accountability' quality program at Bunbury Hospital was supported, subject to procurement processes and budget availability.

Key Matters for Discussion

- The A/Chief Executive Officer's report provided an update on monthly performance, senior staff movements and key developments within WACHS, with the Board particularly acknowledging the achievement of organisational wide accreditation following the independent Corporate EQuIP survey in May 2017;
- The draft WA Country Health Service Country Cancer Strategy was discussed and support provided for further external consultation with stakeholders;
- The Board discussed proposed changes to the WACHS Royalties for Region funded programs and in particular the recently announced changes to the Southern Inland Health Initiative program in 2017 to 2019;
- The State Government's Election commitments relating to country health services were discussed along with initial implementation planning for these initiatives;
- A progress report was received on Bunbury Hospital's emergency access (WEAT) recovery plan and the significant progress on implementing the plan and performance improvement was acknowledged;
- The next steps in the development of the WACHS Strategic Plan for 2018/2021 were considered and discussed, along with the process for engagement with staff and stakeholders;
