27-28 NOVEMBER 2025

This communiqué highlights regional engagement activities undertaken by the Board during their visit to the Midwest and key points of discussion from the Board meeting.

MIDWEST REGIONAL ENGAGEMENT

In November 2025 the Board travelled to the Midwest region, where they split into two groups to visit local staff and stakeholders across the region. Collectively, the Board visited Northampton, Mullewa, Morawa, Three Springs, Mingenew and Dongara before returning to Geraldton.

Throughout the regional visit, the Board saw firsthand the value of Multi-Purpose Service (MPS) models in providing improved access to health and aged care services – demonstrated well in Morawa, Northampton and Three Springs, areas which are unable to support both a hospital and a separate aged care home, but instead have an innovative, flexible and integrated service delivery.

Stakeholders joined the Board at various sites and welcomed discussion on local experiences from representatives from District Health Advisory Councils, St John Ambulance staff and volunteers, police, education, community and other organisations. The Board's commitment to their connection to country communities remains an important component of the regional engagement program.

In Geraldton, St John of God Hospital Executive staff welcomed the Board with a presentation that highlighted the value of partnerships in health care, followed by a tour of the hospital. The Board met with Geraldton hospital staff and local stakeholders following their Board meeting and then met with Multiplex contractors for a tour of the Geraldton Health Campus redevelopment.

- The Chief Executive provided an update on executive appointments, workforce development initiatives, service delivery matters, and the progress of key projects.

- A presentation on the status of the Geraldton Health Campus redevelopment project was provided ahead of the Board tour of the redevelopment.

- The Finance Committee met on 24 November 2025. The Board was provided an overview on financial performance.
